





Thank you for your email of 8 June 2018 to the Ministry of Education requesting the following information:

"I'm keen to find out how much the MoE has spent on upgrading school networks under SNUP & WSNUP.

Ideally looking for the amount over the past 5 & 10 years if possible, or an annual breakdown."

Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

The total budgeted allocation for School Network Upgrades, including the Managed Network, over the last five years is \$253 million. The total overall budget is \$497 million over the last 14 years.

The table below outlines the broadband internet facilities spend by year including School Network Upgrades and Managed Network for the past five financial years:

Amount	\$50,622,653	\$68,971,984	\$57,235,730	\$37,503,161	\$33,846,225
