pay its suppliers for goods and services. If there is a range, please provide detail on
all payment terms.

Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

In particular, clause 4.1 states that:

Following delivery the Ministry will pay the price by the 20th of the month following the month of receipt of your valid invoice.

The Ministry may agree alternative payment terms depending on the nature of the goods and services being supplied. Typically these can range from immediate payment to 7 or 14 days following receipt of a valid invoice.
