Partnership Schools Kura Hourua: Policy for Round Five

Portfolio

Education

On 7 December 2016, the Cabinet Social Policy Committee (SOC):

- 1 **noted** that SOC:
 - agreed in March 2012 that charter schools be developed to provide targeted response to educational underachievement in disadvantaged areas [SOC Min (12) 2/1];
 - agreed in July 2012 that charter schools be called Partnership Schools | Kura Hourua (PSKH) [SOC Min (12) 14/14];
- 2 **noted** that the PSKH model extends the menu of options for parents and students by offering greater freedom and flexibility to achieve quality education outcomes in return for stronger accountabilities;
- noted that in November 2013, SOC noted that the main policy benefits for further application rounds for establishing PSKHs would be increased choice for parents and a wider range of educational options [SOC Min (13) 24/4];
- 4 **agreed** that provision be made in each application round to focus on a government preference;
- agreed that for PSKH application Round 5, the focus be on Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) education;
- 6 **noted** that if no suitable STEM-focussed applications, or others of interest, are received for PSK application Round 5, all selected PSKH will continue the current focus on priority learners;
- 7 **noted** that as part of Budget 2016, Cabinet agreed to the operating contingency *Additional Partnership Schools 2018 and 2019* [CAB-16-MIN-0189.10];
- 8 **agreed** that funding, performance standards, and accountabilities will be negotiated by the Ministry of Education according to the successful applicants within the parameters of the Budget provision, referred to in paragraph 7 above;

- agreed to change the principal's salary component of the establishment grant for PSKH application Rounds 4 and 5 so that:
 - 9.1 primary schools receive up to one year of a principal's salary;
 - 9.2 secondary schools receive up to five terms/quarters of a principal's salary;
- **noted** that the Guaranteed Minimum Roll will be extended from one term to up to one year for PSKH application Round 3 and all subsequent application rounds.
