Signed as a Deed.

This Supplementary Agreement is made on the 17th day of December 2019

between:

Her Majesty the Queen in right of New Zealand acting by and through the Minister of Education ("the Minister")

and

St Mary's College Auckland Ltd ("the Proprietor"),

together the Parties

in relation to ST MARY'S COLLEGE, AUCKLAND ("the School").

Background


- A. By an Integration Agreement dated **11 November 1982** and as amended by any subsequent supplementary agreements between the Minister and the Proprietor ("Integration Agreement"), the School was established as a State integrated school pursuant to the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.
- B. The Parties have agreed to amend the Integration Agreement on the terms below. The Integration Agreement will be read subject to the modifications set out in this Supplementary Agreement from the date this Supplementary Agreement is executed by the Parties, and any references to the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 will be treated as references to the corresponding provisions of the Education Act 1989.


Amendments


