together **the Parties**


in relation to ***EXCELLERE COLLEGE, WHANGAREI*** ("the School").

Background

- A. By an Integration Agreement dated **26 September 1996** between the Minister and the Proprietor ("**Integration Agreement**"), the School was established as a State integrated school pursuant to the ***Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 / Education Act 1989***.
- B. The Parties have agreed to amend the Integration Agreement on the terms below. The Integration Agreement will be read subject to the modifications set out in this Supplementary Agreement from the date this Supplementary Agreement is executed by the Parties, and any references to the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 will be treated as references to the corresponding provisions of the Education Act 1989.
