## Background

- A. By an Integration Agreement dated 10<sup>th</sup> April 1995 and as amended by any subsequent supplementary agreements between the Minister and the Proprietor ("Integration Agreement"), the School was established as a State integrated school pursuant to the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.
- B. The Parties have agreed to amend the Integration Agreement on the terms below. The Integration Agreement will be read subject to the modifications set out in this Supplementary Agreement from the date this Supplementary Agreement is executed by the Parties, and any references to the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 will be treated as references to the corresponding provisions of the Education Act 1989.

## Amendments

The Plan annexed to the Second Schedule of the Integration Agreement is deleted and replaced with the Plan annexed to this Supplementary Agreement.
