The Integration Agreement will be read subject to the modifications set out in this Supplementary Agreement from the date this Supplementary Agreement is executed by the Parties, and any references to the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 will be treated as references to the corresponding provisions of the Education Act 1989.
