together the Parties

in relation to Baradene College ("the School").

Background

- A. By an Integration Agreement dated 26 March 1983 between the Minister and the original Proprietor ("Integration Agreement"), the School was established as a State integrated school pursuant to the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.
- B. The Parties have agreed to amend the Integration Agreement on the terms below. The Integration Agreement will be read subject to the modifications set out in this Supplementary Agreement from the date this Supplementary Agreement is executed by the Parties, and any references to the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 will be treated as references to the corresponding provisions of the Education Act 1989.

Effective date

The effective date of this agreement is 1 January 2021.

Amendments

- 2 Clause 8 of the Integration Agreement is deleted and replaced with the following:
 - "8. The maximum roll of the school shall be, from 1 January of each year, as follows, subject to provision of the required teaching spaces by the proprietor:

2021: 1,300

2022: 1,325

2023: 1,350

2024: 1,375

2025: 1,400

2026: 1,425

2027: 1,450

2028: 1,475


