

## SUPPLEMENTARY AGREEMENT

Signed as a Deed.

This Supplementary Agreement is made on the 12 day of December 2019.

between:

**Her Majesty the Queen in right of New Zealand** acting by and through the **Minister of Education** (“the Minister”)

and

**The Roman Catholic Bishop of the Diocese of Auckland** (“the Proprietor”),

together **the Parties**

in relation to **Te Kura o Hata Maria (Pawarenga)** (“the School”).

### Background

- A. By an Integration Agreement dated 1 March 1983, between the Minister and the Proprietor (“Integration Agreement”), the School was established as a State integrated Catholic school pursuant to the Private School Conditional Integration Act 1975, initially known as St Mary’s School (Pawarenga).
- B. The Parties have agreed to amend the Integration Agreement on the terms below. The Integration Agreement will be read subject to the modifications set out in this Supplementary Agreement from the date this Supplementary Agreement is executed by the Parties, and any references to the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 will be treated as references to the corresponding provisions of the Education Act 1989.

### Amendments

- 1 Clause 14 of the Integration Agreement is deleted and replaced with the following:

“14 (a) Subject to subclause (b), an advertisement for the position of Principal of the School shall, in accordance with Section 464(a) of the Education Act 1989, state that a willingness and ability to take part in religious instruction appropriate to the special character of the School shall be a condition of appointment. Any person so appointed to the position of Principal shall accept these requirements as a condition of appointment. The Principal so appointed shall accept and recognise a responsibility to maintain and preserve the special character of the School.

- (b) Subclause (a) does not apply to an advertisement for a temporary Principal, being for appointment for a term of one year or less, except that the Principal so appointed shall accept and recognise a responsibility to maintain and preserve the special character of the School.”
