in relation to Our Lady of the Assumption School (Christchurch) ("the School").

Background

- A. By an Integration Agreement dated **21 February 1981** between the Minister and the Proprietor ("Integration Agreement"), the School was established as a State integrated school pursuant to the **Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.**
- B. The Parties have agreed to amend the Integration Agreement on the terms below. The Integration Agreement will be read subject to the modifications set out in this Supplementary Agreement from the date this Supplementary Agreement is executed by the Parties, and any references to the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 will be treated as references to the corresponding provisions of the Education Act 1989.

Amendments

- 1 Clause 8 of the Integration Agreement is varied as follows:
 - (a) The words "three hundred (300)" in the fifth line are deleted and replaced with the words "three hundred and fifty (350) from 1 January 2022, subject to commencement of property works for two classrooms by no later than 31 December 2021".
