- A. By an Integration Agreement dated 4 May 1992 between the Minister and the Proprietor ("Integration Agreement"), the School was established as a State integrated school.
- B. The Parties have agreed to amend the Integration Agreement on the terms below. The Integration Agreement will be read subject to the modifications set out in this Supplementary Agreement from the date this Supplementary Agreement is executed by the Parties, and any references to the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 or Education Act 1989 will be treated as references to the corresponding provisions of the Education and Training Act 2020.

## **Amendments**

1. Clause 20 of the Integration Agreement is varied as follows:

By replacing paragraph (b):

" (b) the maximum roll is 335 students; the maximum day roll is 155 students and maximum boarder roll is 180 students."
