SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

ST JOHN'S COLLEGE, HAMILTON

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 26 day of September two thousand and eighteen (2018) BETWEEN THE ROMAN CATHOLIC BISHOP OF HAMILTON ("the Proprietor") of the first part and HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "The Minister") of the second part.

WHEREAS

- A By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 25th September 1980 as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established **St John's College, Hamilton** as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the School").
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend Clause 8 of the Deed of Agreement pursuant to section 423(3) of the Education Act 1989.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the words "seven hundred and fifty (750)" in line 5 of Clause 8 of the Deed of Agreement be deleted and the words "nine hundred and twenty five (925), phased in over two years to 850 from 2019 and 925 from 2020. Subject to the Proprietor providing the additional teaching spaces required for the maximum roll." be substituted therefor.
- THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
