Who should complete this form?

This form is for the board of a kura/school with significant challenges and one that wishes to offer or reoffer the Principal Recruitment Allowance to attract a highly effective tumuaki/principal.

To be eligible a kura/school needs to:

- » have a principal permanent vacancy
- meet most or all of the school eligibility criteria as determined by the Secretary for Education

Ideally before advertising a principal permanent vacancy, a board would submit this form to the Ministry for prior approval and to confirm its eligibility.

If the board's preferred tumuaki/principal does not meet these criteria, the board may still appoint them, however the tumuaki/principal will not be able to receive the allowance.
