



Education Report: Amending the Annual Planning Licensing Criteria for Early Learning Services and Amendments for Kōhanga Reo

Purpose of Report

This paper is for you to:

- agree to prescribe amended licensing criteria to require licensed early learning services to have regard for the National Education and Learning Priorities in annual planning.
- agree to prescribe amended licensing criteria for k\u00f6hanga reo following consultation with Te K\u00f6hanga National Trust.
- **agree** to defer the commencement date of licensing criteria previously agreed on 3 June 2021.

Summary

You recently agreed to amend licensing criteria relating to the minimum indoor temperature for licensed centre-based, home-based, and hospital-based early learning services, and for these services to demonstrate regard for the National Education and Learning Priorities (the NELP) in self-review (METIS 1250403 refers). These changes were proposed in response to consultation as part of Tranche 1 of the Early Learning Regulatory Review.

As part of the NELP consultation we proposed amending criteria for services' annual plan, self-review, and philosophy statement. On the basis of consultation feedback we recommended an amendment to self-review only. You have requested that we make an additional amendment to annual planning requirements to complement self-review.

On 1 July 2021 we completed work with Te Kōhanga Reo National Trust on equivalent licensing criteria for affiliated kōhanga reo and request your approval to prescribe these amended criteria.

To ensure all early learning services are subject to the same minimum standards and provide adequate time for all services to prepare for these changes, we are proposing a deferred commencement date of 31 August 2021 for criteria amendments increasing the minimum indoor room temperature to 18 degrees Celsius and 1 January 2022 for criteria amendments to support services to have regard for the NELP.

Background

- On 3 June 2021 you prescribed amendments to the ECE licensing criteria for centrebased, home-based and hospital-based services (METIS 1250403 refers).
 - a. increasing the minimum indoor room temperature to 18°C, as recommended by World Health Organisation guidelines
 - requiring services to have regard for the Statement of National Education and Learning Priorities (NELP) in self-review requirements.
- Under Tranche One of the Early Learning Regulatory Review we also consulted on amending the licensing criteria for annual plan and philosophy statement to incorporate the NELP. In response to feedback that the NELP should not be included in the philosophy statement, as this is unique to the service, and that including it in annual planning would create an unnecessary compliance burden, we recommended not making any change to philosophy statement or annual planning criteria.
- 3 You asked that the annual plan criteria also be amended to have regard for the NELP.
- We have also worked with Te Kōhanga Reo National Trust to ensure that the amended criteria reflect their kaupapa, and they have agreed to the wording outlined in Annex 2.
- Due to the extended consultation to ensure that all licensed early learning services and kōhanga reo are subject to the same minimum standards, we propose deferring the commencement date of the criteria amendments to increase the minimum temperature in early learning services previously agreed on 3 June 2021 until 31 August 2021.

Next Steps

- GMA8 ¹ Annual Plan, currently requires services to have a documented plan to guide the service's operation identifying 'who', 'what' and 'when' in relation to key tasks each year. Services are not required to provide this plan to the Ministry of Education but must ensure that annual plan is available upon request to show the Ministry how the service intends to ensure ongoing compliance with all regulatory requirements.
- Amending GMA8² to require services to document how key tasks will have regard to the statements of the NELP will complement the amendments previously prescribed in self-review. This amendment ensures that the statements of the NELP are not only considered in reviewing the services past operation but are specifically considered in guiding a service's future operation.
- To mitigate any perceived compliance burden, the guidance accompanying the criteria will be phased in a series of updates to support a focused approach to meeting the priorities. This aligns with the sector-wide approach to implementing the NELP with a focus on strengthening educationally powerful connections with learners/ākonga, whānau, communities, and iwi/hapū and mana whenua.
- 9 Due to the requirement for services to have regard to the statements of the NELP in a documented annual plan we propose a commencement date of 1 January 2022. To align the criteria amendments previously agreed requiring services to have regard to

the NELP in the recorded outcomes of any self-review, we also propose deferring the commencement date for this criteria amendment previously agreed on 3 June 2021 until 1 January 2022.

Prescribing licensing criteria

- If you wish to pursue the proposed changes to the Licensing Criteria, you must sign and date the changes themselves in Annex 3. As advised in METIS 1250403 the Secretary for Education must then publish a notice in the *New Zealand Gazette*, and the amended licensing criteria presented to the House of Representatives within 16 sitting days.
- The Cabinet Paper requesting approval to amend the Regulations was updated to notify Cabinet of your intention to amend the annual planning criteria.
- All prescribed criteria for indoor temperature in respect of centre-based, home-based and hospital-based services, and kōhanga reo will take effect from 31 August 2021.
- All prescribed criteria for having regard to the NELP in an annual plan and recorded outcomes of self-review in respect of centre-based, home-based and hospital-based services, and kōhanga reo will take effect from 1 January 2022
- The Ministry will announce these amendments on 13 July 2021.

Proactive Release

It is intended that this Education Report is proactively released following Cabinet approval of the regulatory changes alongside the Early Learning Regulatory Review Cabinet Paper, Education Report and consultation report, as per your expectation that information be released as soon as possible. Any information which may need to be withheld will be done so in line with the provisions of the Official Information Act 1982.

1 Title

These criteria may be cited as the Licensing Criteria for Kōhanga Reo affiliated with Te Kōhanga Reo National Trust Amendment Criteria 2021.

2 Commencement

These criteria come into effect on 1 January 2022.

3 Principal Criteria amended

These criteria amend Ngā Paearu whai Raihana mō ngā Kōhanga Reo e hono ana ki Te Kōhanga Reo National Trust 2008 | the Licensing Criteria for Kōhanga Reo affiliated with Te Kōhanga Reo National Trust 2008.

4 Criterion GMA6 is revoked and the following criterion substituted

"GMA6

An ongoing <u>process</u> of self-review and internal evaluation helps the Kōhanga Reo maintain and improve the quality of Te Kaupapa o Te Kōhanga Reo for mokopuna.

Documentation required:

1. A process for reviewing and evaluating the Kōhanga Reo operation by the whānau of Te Kōhanga Reo.

The process is consistent with criterion C11/GMA4, and includes a timeline for planned self-review and internal evaluation of key areas of Kōhanga Reo operation.

2. Recorded outcomes from the self-review and internal evaluation process. Outcomes will have regard for the Statement of National Education and Learning Priorities (NELP).

5 Criterion GMA8 is revoked and the following criterion substituted

"GMA8 An annual plan guides the Kōhanga Reo operation.

Documentation required:

An annual plan identifying 'who', 'what', and 'when' in relation to key tasks the Kōhanga Reo intends to undertake each year, and how key tasks will have regard to the Statement of National Education and Learning Priorities (NELP).
