## **Employment Strategy Report Back Six-Monthly Update**

#### **Purpose**

1. To provide information on the Employment Strategy Report Back: Six-Monthly Update that Minister Sepuloni is presenting to Cabinet on 17 March.

#### Comment

- 2. A draft of this Cabinet paper was considered by EET Ministers at your meeting on 25 March 2021.
- 3. At that meeting, you discussed whether there should be a separate Action Plan focused on women. Since then, Ministers Tinetti and Sepuloni have had a follow up discussion and confirmed that a separate plan is the preferred approach.
- 4. The Cabinet paper identifies an opportunity to use the Employment Strategy as a framework for improving coordination of labour market polices across government (refer para 7). Minister Sepuloni intends to discuss this with EET Ministers before the next six-monthly report back.
- 5. Ministry of Education officials and EET Deputy Chief Executives have also reviewed this paper and are broadly comfortable with the update and approach.
- 6. The Ministry of Education has provided input into the two completed action plans; Youth Employment Action Plan (released August 2019) and Working Matters Disability Employment Action Plan (released August 2020).
- 7. The Ministry of Education is responsible for a number of actions in the Youth Employment Action Plan, including the Reform of Vocational Education. As part of COVID-19 response and recovery planning, you have instructed Ministry officials to accelerate the establishment of Workforce Development Councils with the aim of having these in place by mid-2021. Workforce Development Councils will play a key role in achieving one of the strategies' long-term objectives building a skilled workforce that meets business needs.
