Hohepa School Context

- Hohepa School is a fully registered private school catering for students aged from seven to 21 who have very special requirements for their care and education. Students come from all over New Zealand. Most parents live outside Hawke's Bay. All students are on the Ongoing Resourcing Scheme (ORS) which funds extra support through therapy programmes and teacher aides to assist the teachers in the classroom. The Rudolf Steiner philosophy provides a foundation for what happens within Hohepa.
- The main administration and adult facilities are based at Clive (South end of Napier), while the school and children's homes are at the Poraiti site, which is to the north end of Napier, near Taradale. Organic farming occurs on both sites, each site being approximately 21 hectares (50 acres).

Education Review Office

The school was last visited by the Education Review Office (ERO) 2016 where ERO recommended that on the basis of the information obtained during the review, ERO considers that Hohepa School meets the criteria for registration as a private school set out in the Education Act 1989.

At the end of 2021 and the beginning of 2022, Hohepa School experienced some staffing challenges as a result of the vaccination mandate. A number of specialist teachers and support staff chose not to be vaccinated. As a result, the school put out a call to the wider Hohepa community for support.
