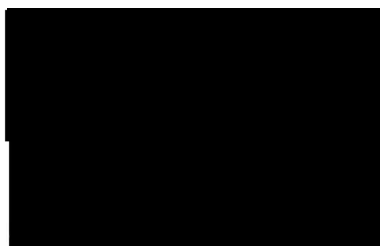

Thank you for your email of 7 May 2021 to the Ministry of Education requesting the following information:

1. *I would like to know the date that each school in Auckland first introduced an enrolment scheme (school zone).*

Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (the OIA).

Please find attached **Appendix A** which provides you with the effective dates of the Auckland enrolment schemes currently in place for 327 schools in the Auckland region.

Please note that there are a few caveats to be aware of, as this is historic data:

1. We have provided the date that the enrolment scheme became effective. The difference between approval dates and effective dates can vary.
2. If a zone has been amended, the most recent date of an amendment will be listed as the effective date. This means that some original schemes are older than the effective date shown in the spreadsheet.
3. There are a number of zones that have been approved recently but have not yet come into effect. These have not been included.
4. This data does not include state integrated schools.
5. Not all Auckland schools have enrolment schemes.

Please note, the Ministry now proactively publishes OIA responses on our website. As such, we may publish this response on our website after five working days. Your name and contact details will be removed.
