



REVIEW OF ENROLMENT SCHEME

The board of **Chisnallwood Intermediate School** has reviewed the operation of the school's enrolment scheme and has reached the following conclusion.

Under Section 11PA(1)(b) of the Education Act 1989, the board seeks the Secretary's agreement with the board's assessment of the situation.
