Thank you for your email of 17 September 2018 to the Ministry of Education requesting the following information:

I would like to request the 2017 revenue data (all the fields defined in the Kiwi Park Model) and the 2012 to 2017 expenditure data for all state and state integrated schools. For the expenditure data please provide all the expenditure fields that that are defined in the Kiwi Park Model spreadsheet https://www.education.govt.nz/assets/Documents/School/Running-a-school/School-finances/SINGLE-FINAL-Kiwi-Park-Model-Updated-2-Nov17.xlsx in the 'Kiwi Park Data' tab.

Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

I have attached one spreadsheet which provides detailed school financial revenue and expenditure accounts from 2012 to 2017. Please note the following caveats:

- School financial year (January to December) information was extracted from the Financial Information Database for Schools (FIDS). The Ministry collects financial data as recorded by schools within their audited annual financial statements. As data is updated as accounts are received, this information is subject to change.
- School financial information not provided to the Ministry will result in missing rows of data.
- 3. Financial data is drawn from individual schools' audited financial accounts. The Ministry cannot guarantee the accuracy of the information.
- 4. In some cases a single, combined Board of Trustees may administer more than one school. In these cases, the value in "Number of Schools" will be greater than one.
- This data supersedes the 2012-2016 revenue data previously provided to the New Zealand Herald. Data is continually being updated as schools provide their financial returns to the Ministry.
- This dataset was last updated on 27 July 2018.

Please note, the Ministry now proactively publishes OIA responses on our website. As such, we may publish this response on our website after five working days. Your name and contact details will be removed.
