Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

It is important to note that exclusions and expulsions do not necessarily reflect trends in student behaviour because they also capture a school's reaction to such behaviour. What one school may choose to exclude a student for, another may not. The number of these events should not be used as a proxy measure for total student behaviour.

I am providing you with four tables, attached as **Appendix A**, that detail the number of exclusions by ethnicity (2008 - 2017), exclusions by behavioural types alcohol, drugs (including substance abuse) and smoking (by ethnicity), and expulsions by behavioural types alcohol, drugs (including substance abuse) and smoking (by ethnicity).

When the Ministry is notified of an individual incident of exclusion and/or expulsion, only one behavioural type is reported. As such, we are unable to advise the number of students who have been excluded or expelled for more than one behaviour.

We recognise that schools face real challenges supporting children and young people with challenging behaviour.

The Ministry provides a range of supports to assist schools to manage challenging behaviour, including training workshops. For example, Understanding Behaviour, Responding Safely, which is available to all schools, focuses on prevention and de-escalation strategies and is run by experienced behaviour management specialists (who also offer ongoing support).

We also know that early intervention improves long term outcomes for children so the Ministry is investing around \$35 million to expand the Behaviour Service to reach an additional 1,000 children each year aged 0 to 8. An additional 56 specialist staff, including psychologists, service managers, early intervention teachers, learning support special education advisors and kaitakawaenga, will be recruited.

Notes:

Where more than one ethnicity group has been identified, ethnicity is prioritised in the order Māori, Pasifika, Asian, other groups except European/Pākehā, and European/Pākehā.

Exclusion means the formal removal of a student aged under 16 from the school and the requirement that the student enrol elsewhere.

Expulsion means the formal removal of a student aged 16 or over from the school. If the student wishes to continue schooling, he or she may enrol elsewhere.

Private Schools are excluded. Private school data is unreliable as it is not mandatory for private schools to report their stand-downs and suspension.
