Dear

Thank you for your email of 8 October 2018 to the Ministry of Education (the Ministry) requesting the following information:

- Could you please provide data on how many Otago and Southland pupils were stood down, suspended, excluded or expelled in 2016 and 2017.
- It would also be good to know what they were disciplined for (eg Alcohol, arson, continue disobedience, drugs etc). And could you also provide national statistics please?

Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

Please find attached **Appendix One** providing data on the numbers of Otago, Southland and National pupils who were stood-down, suspended, excluded or expelled (including reasons) for 2016 and 2017.

Values less than 5 in the cohort of data have been withheld under section 9(2)(a) of the Act, to protect the privacy of natural persons and to avoid identifying individual students. These values are shown as 'x' in the Appendix.

Definitions of measures used

A **stand-down** is the removal of a student for a period of up to five days in a school term, where the decision is made by the Principal. A student may only be stood-down for a total of 10 school days in a year.

A **suspension** is the formal removal of a student from a state or state-integrated school on a temporary basis until the school board of trustees (the board) decides the final outcome at a meeting. The board can then either:

- lift the suspension (with or without conditions),
- extend the suspension, or
- exclude the student (if under 16) or expel the student (if aged 16 years or over).

Exclusions and expulsions are subsets of suspension where an enrolment is terminated. If the student is aged under 16, the board may decide to exclude the student from the school, with the requirement that the student enrols elsewhere.

Considerations when interpreting the data

It's important to note that stand-downs, suspensions, exclusions and expulsions are measures of a school's reaction to the behaviour. While one school may opt to suspend a student over a particular incident, another school may not. The number of these incidents should not be used as a proxy measure for total student behaviour.

The school-based Resource Teacher: Learning and Behaviour (RTLB) service supports clusters of schools develop whole school behaviour management strategies to help manage the additional learning needs of students and help enhance students' learning participation and wellbeing.

The 'Guidelines for Registered Schools in New Zealand on the Use of Physical Restraint' resource has been developed to help schools address the uncertainty staff experience when faced with a student exhibiting difficult behaviour that may escalate into a dangerous situation. The guide's aim is to strengthen the good practice already happening in schools, and avoid the need for physical restraint. Our Learning Support professionals work specifically to support children and young people with higher levels of challenging behaviour, including those whose behaviour management plans include the possibility of physical restraint. A training workshop for behaviour management that focuses on preventative and de-escalation techniques, 'Understanding Behaviour – Responding Safely', has been developed for New Zealand schools. It is delivered by Learning Support professionals and RTLB who can also provide ongoing support to schools.
