Thank you for your email of 20 September 2018 to the Ministry of Education requesting the following information:

- 1. Copies of all licensing applications, assessments and checklists since its [Little Lights Kindy] first application to be licensed.
- 2. Copies of each and every record of measurement of indoor activity area space at the Little Lights Kindy and the date, showing whether or not the measurement of indoor activity space included the use of mezzanine floors for children's activities and sleep.
- 3. When and for what reason or reasons did the Ministry of Education first become aware that mezzanine floors were used for children's activities and sleep?

Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

1. Copies of all licensing applications, assessments and checklists since its first application to be licensed.

I am refusing this part of your request under section 18(f) of the Act as the requested information cannot be made available without substantial collation and research.

There are potentially hundreds of documents in scope of part one of your request and the time required to locate and collate these documents would impact significantly on the operations of the Ministry in taking staff away from their core role of supporting Early Childhood Education services.

We have considered whether extending the timeframe would remove the reasons for refusing this part of your request, and on balance we do not believe this would enable us to process the request.

Copies of each and every record of measurement of indoor activity area space at the Little Lights Kindy and the date, showing whether or not the measurement of indoor activity space included the use of mezzanine floors for children's activities and sleep.

We have identified two documents within the scope of this part of your request. These are attached as **Appendix one**.

Some names have been withheld under section 9(2)(a) of the Act to protect the privacy of individuals.

3. When and for what reason or reasons did the Ministry of Education first become aware that mezzanine floors were used for children's activities and sleep?

On 19 March 2015 we became aware that the mezzanine floor was being used for sleep when we were undertook a licensing assessment visit.

We instructed the service to take immediate steps to ensure a compliant sleep space. Detailed information about this is located within **Appendix one**.

A change of management visit occurred 19 March 2015,

(SPC) was present. During our walk through the centre we discovered that children in the over two areas were being slept in the loft (a mezzanine floor). There were two mezzanine floors in this area, one is the designated sleep area, and the other was used for supervised activities.

There are 8-10 steps to reach the top of the floor, the staircase is very narrow, and when I reached the third step from the top I had to stop as the roof was so low. There were several children resting supervised by two teachers who were seated on the floor. The protective railing around the floor was covered by curtains to keep the lighting low. This is difficult to supervise the teachers by the persons responsible. Ventilation was not ideal at all even though they had a fan blowing. There was very little space between each mattress. One teacher had to crawl along a narrow space between mattresses to tend to a child because she couldn't stand as the roof was low.

The centre manager advised us that the loft space was utilised for activities and as a sleep space for children. When asked what the

evacuation procedures for the sleep area, the answer was, there is none.

Heavy shelving was not secured to the wall, resources, boxes, and other items were stored on top of the shelving. The bag lockers were arranged in a position that children using the higher lockers could not put their bags in properly and as a result the bags were falling down on children. Suggested stringing a curtain wire across the top shelf or lower the shelf. In the front entrance of the centre there stands a large fish tank that was not secure to the wall.

A re-licensing visit was conducted by ministry in 4 January 2010. The mezzanine floors were in the floor plans. The floors may have been used for storage not sleeping at the time of licensing. The operative fire evacuation scheme was approved 17 February 2010 by NZ Fire

Service.

Initial Follow-Up Details:

The cervice provider had conducted a health and safety check prior to our management visit. There was a list of items that the centre manager was asked to complete prior to our visit. The centre manager had not complied to the request of the service provider.

The service provider contact will support the centre manager to reapplying for an approved operative evacuation scheme.

The SPC will review the current sleeping space and relocate the

designated sleep area that is compliant.

Possible temporary closure while changes are undertaken.

Last ERO review conducted 17 June 2014 the result was very well placed. ERO

conducted a review in 2011 again very well placed.

The 2011 review identified that the centre was now in their new purpose built facility. There was no mention in both reports that children were sleeping in the mezzanine

areas or that the areas were used for activities.

Rationale of Decision: Although a number of breaches were identified at the CoM visit, Evolve Management took immediate action and amended the H&S and P&F breaches on the action plan within the week. The sleeping of children up on the mezzanine floor (loft) was of concern for me and the SPC. There was no procedure for evacuation sleeping children in an emergency. The centres fire evacuation scheme was approved in 2010.

Risk Management Officer NZFS in regards to my concern Contacted Their 2010 application showed no mezzanine floors being used as sleep areas contacted the centre manager and suggested they reapply and must indicate the use of the mezzanine floors for sleeping. The fire service visited the centre to heck the floor and was satisfied with the action plan to evacuate. The centres ire evacuation

scheme was approved 8 April 2015.

As all breaches were address within the week, the decision wa provisionally licence the centre. The other recommendations were carried out well

within the agreed timeframe.

MZFS visited the centre and asked that the curtains be removed that surrounded the sleep area and a Fire Action notice be placed at the bottom of the staircase. The evacuation scheme was approved 8 April 2015 (see attached).

contacted me (see above notes and attached email to COO) sent through photos of the heavy fixtures that were attached securely to the wall including the fish tank. The sleep area on the mezzanine floor was reviewed, with the removal of the curtains the air flow issue was addressed. The mattresses were spaced out to allow for adults to check on sleeping children, rosters changed to allow the children not sleeping to be supervised by another teacher during this time, reducing the number of sleepers in the space.

Regulatory breaches HS6 & 10 PF 12 & 37 were completed within a two week time frame, the Reg 09 (1) (c) was received 8 April 2015. Therefore all breaches were completed by 8 April 2015.

I was wondering whether it meets all HS and PF criteria really (e.g. PF2). Are teachers able to safely get children up and down the stairs on a daily basis? Is there a gate or similar at the top of each mezzanine staircase? Can children (especially younger children) independently and safely access the two mezzanines?
