Thank you for writing to the Ministry of Education on 30 June 2020, to request a list of student management software provider by school.

For the purposes of this request, we have defined "school" as an institution with a Ministry assigned ID number which provides school roll returns. This definition includes Teen Parent Units.

While the Ministry does not hold definitive or comprehensive information on the Student Management Systems (SMSs) used by schools, we have collected information about the SMS used by each school to submit its March 2020 roll returns.

Please find attached a spreadsheet with list of schools and their SMS providers. The data is based on March 2020 roll returns. This data has also been made available to all SMS providers.

This spreadsheet was current as at 16 July 2020, and holds information from all types of state, state integrated and private schools.

When looking at this information, it is important to note the following information:

- Some schools may have an SMS, but did not use it to submit a roll return in March.
- Some schools may have changed their SMS since March 2020.
- Information about students enrolled at an Activity Centre is not provided separately. It is
 provided by the school responsible for each centre.
- Where the "SMS" field for some schools on the spreadsheet is blank, this means that the
 March roll return were not submitted through an SMS. It does not necessarily indicate
 that the school does not have an SMS, but may have chosen to submit this information
 through a different method.
- The host school are responsible for submitting their Teen Parent Unit's roll information, most elect to do this directly from their own SMS. This means that these TPUs will be listed with no SMS, however this does not necessarily mean they do not use one.
